## Class Guiding Verse

### Classroom Rules:

1. RESPECT: yourself, peers, teachers and surroundings.
2. Be in your seat and ready to work when class begins.  
(Tardies will be counted)
1. Be prepared for class every day:
  - A) PENCIL/Pen (**NO homework done in RED, Bright colors or highlighters**)
  - B) Grading Pen (RED or color other than what was used, for grading and corrections)
  - C) Text book, notebook, take home folder, and planners (daily grade taken)
  - D) Cumulative Grade Sheet (chances for extra credit if kept current).
4. Be ready to be a part of the learning process by following directions the first time they are given.

### Class Expectations:

1. When the lesson is given, take notes and follow along when asked.
2. Be quiet during the lesson so that you and those around you may not be disrupted.
3. **When you are sick, you are responsible** to get any missed assignments. Check the "Absent" box for these.
4. If you are absent you have the same number of days you were gone to turn in any homework assigned while you were gone, before counting the homework or project late. **ALL late work will receive a "0" until turned in.**
5. Planners should be filled out in EACH class when assignments given and parents should SIGN each night that they saw your assignments. These will be checked daily for part of your participation grade.

### Grading:

Based on a points system, and varies depending on the subject. Generally:

Homework	10-40pts
Exams/Projects	100-200pts
Notebook Quizzes	50pts/chapter
Participation	10pts/week

**Homework** must be done in pencil OR blue or black pen. Homework will be graded and then corrected in a color other than blue or black pen.

**Late Work:** Any late work will be given an automatic 0% or 0pts. Any late work may be made up, but once turned in a 10% deduction will be made for each day it is late. (5th graders will be given an extra time if needed, but should turn in on time by 2nd Semester). Assignments are considered "late" if they are not completed by the beginning of the class in which they are due.

**Snacks:** NO food is allowed in the classroom unless there is a health issue where a student NEEDs to have food. **The only drink allowed is water and it MUST be in a container (preferably clear) with a lid.** ONLY drinks in lockers should be WATER, unless part of their lunch and left untouched except at lunch.

**Classroom Discipline:**

1. Participation grades will be taken daily, if a student needs to roll the dice that day they will lose their point for the day. 10 pts are given weekly (5pts=planner, 5pts=participation)
2. A Red slips—given if a student has rolled the dice twice that week or conducts themselves in a way in which the teacher views them as disrespectful to CLA property, themselves or others.
3. Any talking back, blatant disrespect, copying of other’s work, or other disrespecting **actions may result in an automatic RED slip, lunch detention or after school detention** (please see CLA Middle School Handbook).
4. **EXTREME circumstances or continued disrespect** will be dealt with directly by the CLA administration.

**Rewards:**

**1. Classroom:**

- ⇒ **Young Bucks/Green Slips** given for outstanding performance or behavior, 4 of these may be cashed in for a classroom coupon.
- ⇒ **Auction** every nine weeks, students can use stamps to buy items (stamps given when class is focused and learning)

**2. Overall Middle School:**

- ⇒ **Fun Friday:** Every Friday students who have all work turned in, have no more than 1 late and have projects up to date may attend a game room during Friday’s studyhall. (5th grade no more than 2 lates 1st semester)
- ⇒ **Six Flags Trip:** Students who have 0 pts for the year will be eligible to attend Six Flags with CLA staff and students. More details on this are in the MS handbook. Specific details of this year’s trip will come home at the beginning of 2nd semester.
